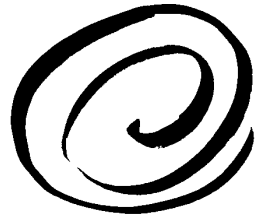

BAPTIZED WE LIVE

In Holy Baptism our gracious heavenly Father sets us free from sin and death by joining us to the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 6). We are born children of a fallen humanity; in the waters of Baptism we are reborn children of God and inheritors of eternal life. By water and the Holy Spirit we are made members of the Church which is the body of Christ. As we live with Him and with His people, we grow in faith, love, and obedience to the will of God.

Michael, Do you desire to be baptized?

Bruni and Sandy, do you desire to make public profession of your faith, affirming your baptism as a sign of your participation in the life of this community of faith and its mission in the world?

P/ Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

C/ **It is right to give him thanks and praise.**

P/ Holy God, mighty Lord, gracious Father: We give you thanks for in the beginning your Spirit moved over the waters and by your Word you created the world, calling forth life in which you took delight. Through the waters of the flood you delivered Noah and his family, and through the sea you led your people Israel from slavery into freedom. In the river Jordan your Son was baptized by John and anointed with the Holy Spirit. By the baptism of Jesus' own death and resurrection you set us free from the power of sin and death and raise us up to live in Him, our Lord and Savior. He made water a sign of the kingdom and of cleansing and rebirth. In obedience to his command, we make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Pour out your Holy Spirit, the power of your living Word, that those who are washed in the waters of baptism may be given new life. To you be given honor and praise through Jesus Christ our Lord, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever.

P/ I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, and confess the faith of the Church, the faith in which we baptize. Do you renounce all the forces of evil, the devil, and all his empty promises?

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

P/ Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic* Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

A READING FROM Acts 19

In Ephesus, Paul encounters people who had received John's baptism of repentance but had never heard of the Holy Spirit or of baptism in the name of Jesus. After Paul baptized them, the Holy Spirit came upon them and empowered them with gifts of the Spirit.

While Apollos was in Corinth, Paul passed through the interior regions and came to Ephesus, where he found some disciples. ²He said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you became believers?" They replied, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." ³Then he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" They answered, "Into John's baptism." ⁴Paul said, "John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, in Jesus." ⁵On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. ⁶When Paul had laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied—⁷altogether there were about twelve of them.

Mark's gospel reports the story of Jesus' baptism with some irony: the one on whom the Spirit descends is himself the one who will baptize others with the Holy Spirit.

John the baptizer appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. ⁵And people from the whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him, and were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. ⁶Now John was clothed with camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. ⁷He proclaimed, "The one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the thong of his sandals. ⁸I have baptized you with water; but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

⁹In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. ¹⁰And just as he was coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens torn apart and the Spirit descending like a dove on him. ¹¹And a voice came from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased."

Children not yet prepared for the Sacrament may come forward for a blessing "that, living in the covenant of their Baptism and in communion with the Church, they may lead godly lives until the day of Jesus Christ."

Take for example this note from Jolleen Christians: "I am traveling to Africa with my friend, Jackie Faulhaber from Rapid City, SD. She will be leading several Christian Leadership Workshops in various locations in Cameroon. The workshops are coordinated by Zarephath Foundation for Development and Leadership. The goal for Jackie's workshops are to reinforce the value of virtuous leadership based on Biblical applications as well as strategic planning/foresight, effects of decisions, innovative problem solving, and transformational leadership in a global context. This is her area of expertise and she has written a book called "A Biblical Approach to Developing the Inner Qualities of a Leader". I am going as her friend, travel companion, and assistant. What I'll exactly be doing... God only knows! We leave on January 8 and will return on January 30. I'm sure it will be a valuable experience for both of us. Please keep Jackie and I in the prayers of the Church for safe travel, funding for the programs, strength and ability for Jackie and I to speak boldly on behalf of the Christian faith, transformation of hearts and minds of those attending, and ultimately that God will be glorified through this experience." I think this would be a very good way to invest our "special mission project" of \$500 budgeted for 2009.
